

## Notes Regarding the *In English* Workbook Selections

The *In English* video-based ESL program has five workbooks, covering Units 1 – 12. Complete examples of Units 1 and 12 are provided here. The TESTs at the conclusion of Units 1 and 12 are also provided as separate documents. We permit downloading and use of these two units free of charge.

Each Unit in the *In English* workbooks contains the following sections:

**S** **SCENE** is the first section, presenting the transcript of the narration of the video segment. The text uses the vocabulary and sentence structures that will be introduced in the unit.

**V** **P** **VOCABULARY** is the second section. The new vocabulary in the unit is listed in the same order in which it is presented on the video. The vocabulary list is also pronounced to the camera in the **PRONUNCIATION** section of the video.

**QUESTIONS** is the third section of the workbook. It is a series of suggested questions designed to expand comprehension of the SCENE. The question numbers correspond to the numbers in the blue triangles which appear on the video in the SCENE section.

**STRUCTURE** is the fourth section. The examples in this section of the workbook reinforce the sentence structures introduced in the unit, showing the new structures in bold print.

**WRITING**, the fifth section, is a series of exercises providing practice in writing questions and answers using the sentence structure of the unit.

**D** **DIALOG** is the sixth section. It is the transcript of the simple dramatic serial which is continuous throughout the 12 units of *In English*. All Dialogs use only the sentence structures and vocabulary previously introduced.

**CONVERSATION**, the seventh section, presents points of departure for students to practice speaking in English with friends or classmates using the sentence structures and vocabulary of the unit. [ Please note: This segment does not appear in the Workbook for Unit 1. ]

**EVALUATION**, the eighth section, is a Cloze test. It provides more practice writing and reading, with emphasis on the structural points of the unit.

**TESTS** for each unit are at the back of the workbooks.
